

















click on the thumbnails

FlyingButtons for InDesign CS4 is a cool script that allows you to generate a PDF-portfolio (like this one) in the blink of an eye.

- *I*) Create an empty document.
- 2) Place some thumbnails (frames) on the page.
- 3) Import an image (link) within each thumbnail. Adjust the fitting/trimming options as you need.
- I suggest you create an Object Style like 'tmb' to globally manage the thumbnail look. In addition, you may create the following specific styles: tmb_off, tmb_over, and/or tmb_click. The script recognizes these suffixes and will apply them to the corresponding button states. You also can use tmb_img_off, tmb_img_over, tmb_im_click, to separately manage internal image style. Make sure to re-apply the root style (tmb) to all the thumbnails before running the script.
- 5) Finally, create an empty frame to contain the full-size images.
- 6) Select the thumbnails and the empty frame, then run the script!
