



*click on the thumbnails!*

*FlyingButtons for InDesign CS4 is a cool script that allows you to generate a PDF-portfolio (like this one) in the blink of an eye.*

- 1) Create an empty document.*
- 2) Place some thumbnails (frames) on the page.*
- 3) Import an image (link) within each thumbnail. Adjust the fitting/trimming options as you need.*
- 4) I suggest you create an Object Style — like 'tmb' — to globally manage the thumbnail look. In addition, you may create the following specific styles: tmb\_off, tmb\_over, and/or tmb\_click. The script recognizes these suffixes and will apply them to the corresponding button states. You also can use tmb\_img\_off, tmb\_img\_over, tmb\_img\_click, to separately manage internal image style. Make sure to re-apply the root style (tmb) to all the thumbnails before running the script.*
- 5) Finally, create an empty frame to contain the full-size images.*
- 6) Select the thumbnails and the empty frame, then run the script!*
